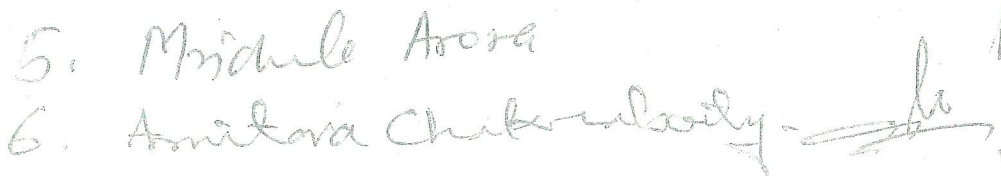

1. The API based PBAS for Category I and Category II will be progressively and prospectively rolled out from the date of the approval of the amendments by the Executive Council. (Ref: 6.3.0 and Note 2 and 3 of the Gazette of India Notification of UGC Regulations on 30th June, 2010, Pages 7886 and 7953)

2. A teacher should acquire the required minimum aggregate score for Category III over two previous stages, taken together. (Ref: Note 5 of the Gazette of India Notification of UGC Regulations on 30th June, 2010, Page 7953)

3. The University/College shall complete the process of screening/selection for various positions under CAS within six months from the date of application of a teacher. (Ref: 6.3.0 the Gazette of India Notification of UGC Regulations on 30th June, 2010, Page 7886)

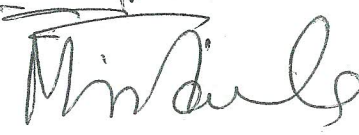
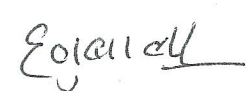


Note of Objection on Undermining the Academic Council

We strongly ~~condemn~~^{oppose} the undermining of the jurisdiction of the Academic Council by denying it the right to deliberate on and decide on the amendments related to the composition of the selection committees for teaching and other positions, guidelines for screening and short listing of applications for teaching positions, workload of teachers, leave rules for teachers etc (various items under Annexure I, Annexure V and Annexure VI of the Recommendation of the concerned Committee), thus denying the Academic Council to consider matters intrinsically related to the academic structure and quality of the University.

For example, the proposed change in Ordinance XIII has not been placed before the Academic Council which is scheduled for 16 August 2013. It has been proposed directly to the Executive Council scheduled for 17 August 2013. Ordinance XIII on workload has been enacted by the Executive Council on the basis of a draft of amendment proposed by the Academic Council. It should not be amended directly in the absence of a proposal from the Academic Council. The issue of teachers' workload is an academic matter. An academic understanding must underlie any formulation in this regard. The manner in which it is stipulated affects academic life and processes.

We, therefore, propose that all such items (various items under Annexure I, Annexure V and Annexure VI of the Recommendation of the concerned Committee) be tabled for the consideration of the Academic Council.

Proposed amendments to Ordinance XXIV

1. Clause vii in pg 32 should be read as follows:

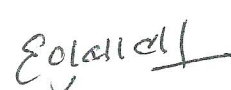
"The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil and/or PhD shall not be considered as research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions"; (the word 'teaching' should be dropped from the original proposal).

2. In pg 61 of CAS 2010, clause vi should be read as follows:

"Assistant Professors with completed service of 5 years at the AGP of 7000 shall be eligible, subject to other API requirements, to move up to the AGP of 8000, provided that the requirement of 5 years will be relaxed if the total service of the incumbent is not less than 11 years (9 years with PhD and 10 years with M.Phil)".

3. In pg 62 of CAS 2010, clause ix should be read as follows:

"Assistant Professors completing 3 years of service in the AGP of 8000 shall be eligible, subject to the prescribed qualifying conditions to move to the Pay Band IV of 37,400 - 67,000 with AGP of 9000 and shall be designated as Associate Professor, provided that the requirement of 3 years will be relaxed if the total service of the incumbent is not less than 14 years (12 years with PhD and 13 years with M.Phil)".

"The incumbent Readers who have completed 6 years as Reader on 1.1.2006 or on completion of 6 years as Reader and Associate Professor together thereafter shall be eligible for promotion to Professorship".

Item 6.5.0 (a) > 'Teaching' should be an essential ~~component~~ criteria for promotion to Professorship in colleges and corresponding modifications should be made in API.

Amended Appendix III > The item 4C on student's Category I, II, III feedback should be deleted.

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In annexure IX, under the heading, CAS-2010, Point 1 ~~(II)~~ the following explanations be added

- (1) Service means teaching experience undergraduate or post graduate or post-graduate classes of the university of Delhi or its colleges or of any other recognised university / college / institution (in India or abroad and or research experience in National Laboratories or R & D organisations (CSIR / ICAR, ORDN, UGC etc)
- (2) It will include teaching experience as Lecturer / Asst. Prof / Director of Ph. Ed (Colleges) / Asst. Directors of Ph. Ed. (University) (Permanent / Temporary / adhoc and research exp as Research Scientist / Research Associate
- (3) Teaching Exp. includes all period spent, on leave except EOL for non-academic purposes
- (4) Point VI ; the following be added
Provided that the requirements of 5 years will be relaxed if the total service of incumbent is not less than 11 years (9 years if Ph.D. and 10 years if M.Phil / M.Tech)
- 5) Point (ix), the following be added.
Provided that the requirements of 3 years be relaxed if total service of incumbent is not less than 14 years (12 years if Ph.D. and 11 years if M. Phil / M. Tech)

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- (6) The date of implementation must be the date on which the scheme be passed by Executive Council of Delhi University.
